The aim of DoQuP project is the definition and implementation of an on-line documentation system for the quality assurance of study programmes in the partner countries (Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan) consistent with the European standards for quality assurance, in order to promote their quality, transparency and comparability at national and international level.

The first step of the project has been the definition of the 'DoQuP standards' for quality assurance of study programmes in partner countries and of the associated 'quality requirements'. Then for each quality requirement the information and data to be documented in order to provide evidence of the study programme quality have been identified

The next step of the project is the definition of appropriate methodologies and procedures of definition, gathering, elaboration and presentation of the identified information and data. The aim of the seminar is to introduce experiences and best practices on methodologies and procedures for the management of the documentation for quality assurance of study programmes of the European countries partners of the project.

Furthermore in a round table the strengths and weaknesses of the implementation of the Bologna process in the European countries partners of the project will be pointed out, with particular reference on the consequences on the educational level of the graduates.
