Honorary guest of InterTech 2012 open ceremony will be prof. Elżbieta Frąckowiak. In 1999-2005 she coordinated NATO Science for Peace research program in the field of carbon materials used for electrochemical energy storage. Since 2009 she is president of Electrochemical Energy Conversion and Storage section and editor in chief of The Open Electrochemistry Journal. In recognition of great research results on new materials and carbon composites and their crucial meaning in power deficiency problems and pollution she was awarded by the Foundation for Polish Science in 2011.
